- Sierra College is a valued educational institution that provides community enrichment through sports, theater, music and cultural events.
- The College is Rocklin's largest employer, a major source of economic activity and jobs.
- Sierra College Board of Trustees proposed a 20-year Facility Master Plan in 2012 and was approved in 2019.
- The campus plan will be financed in part by Measure E, a bond measure approved by voters in June 2018
- The College's portion of the proceeds from the development of College Park will also go to support implementation of the College's Facilities Master Plan










## Trails, Trails, Trails


- College Park includes a robust trails system through an open space area and park that can be expanded in the future via the City's trail master plan.
